

Heavy Vehicle Daily Checks

- Duration:** 4 hours
- Who For:** Compulsory for all company and contractor HSE Advisers and for all personnel responsible for the direct supervision of Heavy Goods vehicle transport activities
Can also be tailored to fit the requirements of other organisations and their equipment
- Aim** The course addresses Company vehicle maintenance requirements, and the responsibilities of drivers of Heavy Goods vehicles to perform daily checks, report defects and maintain basic vehicle records. The course also addresses the supervisory communication skills required to encourage drivers to accept responsibility for performing daily checks, reporting defects and maintaining basic vehicle records.
- Objectives:** Upon successful completion of this course the attendee will be able to:
- Describe Company vehicle maintenance requirements, and the procedures for performing heavy goods vehicle daily checks, reporting defects and maintaining basic vehicle records:
 - Identify and list the names of major items, assemblies and sub-assemblies of heavy goods vehicles that shall be checked by drivers and,
 - Evaluate the competency of heavy goods vehicle drivers to perform daily vehicle checks, report defects and maintain basic vehicle records.
